

#### + National Geospatial Technical Operations Center

- Operational component of the USGS National Geospatial Program
- Provides geospatial products and services supporting key priorities
- The National Map

  - Map Products
  - Geospatial Web Services






# <sup>+</sup> 3D Elevation Program (3DEP)

- Systematically collect enhanced elevation data for the U.S.
  - Lidar in lower 48: QL2 (1 m DEMs)
  - IfSAR in Alaska: QL5 (5 m DEMs)
- Addressing mission-critical requirements for high-quality topographic data
- Leveraging capability & capacity of private industry mapping firms
- Achieve a 25% cost efficiency gain by collecting data in larger projects
- Refresh national elevation data holdings with new products and services












#### <sup>+</sup> How USGS Partners for Lidar

- Broad Agency Announcement (BAA)
  - Geospatial Product and Service Contract (GPSC)
  - Cooperative Agreements (COOP)
- Direct Support
  - Funding partnerships with Federal agencies
  - State and local non-financial support








#### + Broad Agency Announcement (BAA)

- Provides opportunities for the broadest stakeholder community through FedBizOpps.gov and grants.gov
- Federal, state and local governments, tribes, academic institutions, and private sector are eligible
- Partners may propose to use the USGS GPSC or their own contracting vehicles
- National Map Liaisons can assist partners with the process and coordinating partnerships


#### + GPSC

- Architecture and Engineering (A&E) Indefinite
   Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) Contract
- \$750 Million delegated procurement authority for 5 years
- Focus on professional mapping services

Competitive qualification based selection process for

contractors

- GPSC is not a public contract vehicle
  - Must enter into an agreement w with USGS

  - Over 200 subcontractors



#### + COOPs

- BAA applicants execute the USGS Cooperative
   Agreement through their own contracting mechanism
- USGS becomes a funding partner of the COOP acquisition
- COOPs are managed by the USGS National Geospatial Program (NGP) office through the Office of Acquisitions and Grants (OAG)





### <sup>+</sup> Direct Support

#### Federal Agencies

- USGS may partner and cost share directly with Federal agencies to obtain lidar without requiring the use of the BAA process
- No non-federal partners may participate in the project
- Federal agencies can still apply for a BAA
- State and Local
  - USGS may not provide direct cost share funds to non-federal agencies without the BAA process
  - But the GPSC contract and staff expertise may still be utilized to manage the acquisition
  - USGS QC expertise may also be used for certain projects



#### <sup>+</sup> NOAA as 3DEP Partner

- NOAA is a major leader in the 3DEP program and advocate for lidar acquisition
- USGS and NOAA frequently collaborate on various projects
- Acquisitions with coastal and inland areas are coordinated to ensure seamless coverage and core data products
- NOAA and USGS have created a formal relationship to reallocate funding directly between agencies when needed




### <sup>+</sup> USGS in the Coastal Region

- USGS and NOAA have overlapping requirements for lidar in the coastal zone
- Developed a complimentary relationship through the 3DEP program
  - Direct and indirect support provided on various projects
- Partners can ask for additional specifications outside the USGS Lidar Base Specification

Additional requirements can be added to the acquisition to

meet partner needs

- Tide Controlled
- Topo/Bathy collections





# <sup>+</sup> Additional Requirements

- Tidal Coordination is not required by USGS, but it can be added at the request of partners
- Recent examples include:
  - 2018 Georgia Statewide BAA Lidar Acquisition, coastal counties not acquired by NOAA
  - 2018 Southern New Jersey BAA Lidar, collaboration with FEMA along the southern New Jersey coastline
  - Upcoming 2019 Massachusetts Statewide Orthoimagery project




# <sup>+</sup> Developing a Partnership






# <sup>+</sup> Hawaii Big Island Lidar Project

- Coordination with NOAA
- Contractor: Woolpert
- Quality Level = 0 to 1
  - 8 points per sq meter (ppsm) -16ppsm
- Project delayed
  - Change flight plans to fit into short and infrequent weather windows in 2018
  - Waiting for next weather window


#### 2017 Hawai'i Island Lidar by Contract





#### <sup>+</sup> Hawaii Big Island Lidar Project


- Funding partners include: USGS National Geospatial Program and Volcano Hazards Program; FEMA National Office and Region 9; and NRCS National Geospatial Center of Excellence
- Remaining tasks
  - Recollection of areas to fill in clouds
  - Collect the remaining area (~2000 sq miles)





### <sup>+</sup> 2018 Disaster Supplemental Acquisitions

- March 2018, Congress authorized disaster supplemental funds for Hurricanes Harvey, Irma and Maria
- ~\$20M went to USGS 3DEP for post-event lidar 3DEP acquisition and publication
  - Florida
  - Puerto Rico/ US Virgin Islands
  - Texas
  - Georgia/ South Carolina








#### <sup>+</sup> Florida


- Partnership with State of FL
- Sq Miles: ~40,000 sq miles
- Contractor: Dewberry, with many subcontractors
- Acquisition Status: ~20% of state
  - State divided into different areas due to funding and partnerships
  - On hold due to high water levels
- Data to USGS QC: April –
   December 2019
- Data publication: April 2020





### <sup>+</sup> Puerto Rico 2016/2017 Project


- Partnership with NOAA
- Topographic and bathymetric Lidar collected by Dewberry
  - Products included seamless data products incorporating 2014-2016
     NOAA data
  - Collection between Jan 16–May 15, 2016 and Dec 8–March 9, 2017
    - 220 total days but 136 where "weather days" with no flights
- Project was nearing publication when Maria hit
- Provided preliminary data to first responders and critical agencies





#### + Puerto Rico/USVI Recollection

- Sq Miles: 3,590
- Contractor: Dewberry
- Acquisition Status: 83%
  - Started in 2018; flight plans modified to get under persistent cloud cover in the remaining area
- Data to USGS for QC: February Summer 2019
- Data publication: February 2020
- Provided initial non-QC 2018 data to key agencies for recovery
- Both datasets will allow for high accuracy landform change detection





### <sup>+</sup> Texas

Sq Miles: 15,305


Contractor: Fugro

Acquisition Status: Complete as of February 2019

Data to USGS for QC: Fall 2019

■ Data publication: Spring 2020

 Data will be made available to critical agencies as needed







# <sup>+</sup> Georgia and South Carolina

Sq Miles: 21, 240 total


Contractor: Atlantic

Acquisition Status: 24%

Data to USGS for QC : Fall 2019

Data publication: 2020

 Rest of GA will be collected in late 2019 or early 2020
